

CUSTOM COLUMN TIPS

Custom columns are used to create unique statistics which apply to the exact strategy created. Most custom columns simply require basic math (order of operations) and a reference value. References are items such as the Strike Price of Leg 1, the Ask of Leg 2, etc. The syntax for this is simple- leg1strike, leg2ask, etc. Note that there are no capital letters or spaces in a reference. There are special values that do not require a prefix, such as stockprice

Simple Custom Column Examples:

Leg 1 Strike

leg1strike

Bid-Ask Spread of Leg 1

leg1ask - leg1bid

Bid-Ask Spread of Leg 2

leg2ask - leg2bid

Bid-Ask Spread of Leg 1 and Leg 2

(leg1ask + leg2ask) - (leg1bid+leg2bid)

Average Leg 1 and 2 Strike Prices

(leg1strike + leg2strike)/2

Complex Custom Column Example

$$\frac{(((leg2ask-leg2bid)/2)+leg2bid)-(((leg1ask-leg1bid)/2)+leg1bid)}{(((leg1ask-leg1bid)/2)+leg1bid)}$$
